Today, with tank manufacturing in Virginia, IL, Ligonier, IN and Humboldt, IA, Precision Tank is strategically capable of reaching its growing customer base throughout the Midwest and Great Plains. Applicators, nurse equipment, rural fire district equipment and related parts and accessories continue to be manufactured and sold from its Athens, IL facility.
